The work *Breath of Place* investigates the sensorial concepts of touch through corporal experience, touch being felt as a physical element of action, as well as recognizing touch as a vibration through sound. Acknowledging a permeability within these senses, recording this connection as a mapping, an embodied cognition of place.

Allowing a porosity of both the self and work to touch and sound as vessels. Merging this tangibility of sound/vibration leaves both a glitch and a rhythm — hinging us to the proximity of place. Identifying sounds, loosening their individuality, following their line to source as they wrap around both time and viewer, unearthing the visual language for translation.

Through the reciprocal action of touch – mapping that action into the working process with external elements, the work becomes a collaboration between self and place. This cohesive working records time, touch and erasure, shaking the earth off these rhizomes, while simultaneously holding onto and addressing physical connection to external place, bearing witness of a moment and a time.
